Mrs Laurel Kathleen McIntyre was born in Mt Gambier April 17, 1902. A kindergarten teacher by trade, she later turned her interest to raising the profile of women in local government. She founded the Australian Local Government Women's Association in 1964 and served as Honorary Secretary from 1964-1968. She was also an active member of the League of Women Voters and the National Council of Women.

Interested in genealogy and local history she played an active role in the Adelaide-Mt Gambier Club where she again served as honorary secretary. She was a Justice of the Peace from 1963-1983. For her service to the community and her tireless campaigning to have women represented in local government, Mrs McIntyre was awarded the Queen's Silver Jubilee Medal in 1977 and the Order of Australia Medal in 1979. Mrs McIntyre died in 1990, aged 87.
