The South Australian Amateur Swimming Association was founded in 1898. The first volume of minutes of the S.A.A.S.A. contains the ledger of Our Boys Institute for 1883-93: the S.A.A.S.A. used the Institute rooms as a meeting place for a short time after its formation. Also included in the records of the S.A.A.S.A. are the minutes, and other papers, of two related associations which are no longer extant. They are the Freshwater Association of South Australia and the South Australian Women's Amateur Swimming Association.
