Transverse Mercator Projection. Elevations in feet, Mean Sea Level, Port Adelaide.

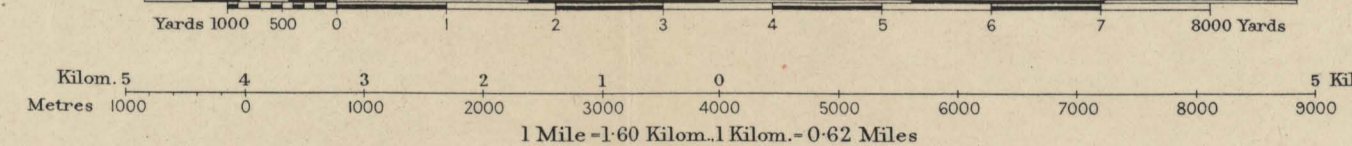
