

CONSENT FORM - TALENT RELEASE

The State Library of South Australia collects, preserves and shares stories of people, places and events in South Australia. These stories can be captured in print, object or digital form. These stories become a part of a collection that may be used for exhibitions, learning programs and promotional purposes, including websites or other online environments.



By completing and returning this talent release, I grant permission for the State Library of South Australia to use:

- Photographs or video of my child
- Creative works made by my child e.g. drawing, writing, artwork
- My child's first name and age to acknowledge their contribution (including school's name is option for parent/guardian)

By completing and returning this talent release, I grant permission for the State Library of South Australia to distribute the material my child submits in the following locations:

- State Library of South Australia's flickr platform on the website
- other publically accessible web platforms including social media accounts
- learning materials used at the State Library of South Australia (e.g. digital assets on iPads)
- exhibition materials for display at the State Library of South Australia
- secure intranet websites
- publicity materials (e.g. brochures, signage)
- external media organisations for publication/broadcast

The permission will continue until I revoke permission in writing to the State Library of South Australia. This can be done at any time.

Notes

- Items might not appear in exactly the form in which they have been submitted and not every item for which permission is granted will be used.
- Where permission is revoked, every effort will be made to remove relevant media from distribution, however this may not be possible or practical in some situations.
- In submitting works to the State Library of South Australia, any material placed on publicly accessible website falls under a Creative Commons Licence (CC-BY-NC) and will be available to download and use. This licence is perpetual, irrevocable, free, worldwide, non-exclusive and allows for the replication, distribution, display, performance and remixing of copyrighted work for non-commercial purposes, provided that the author is credited
- The Flickr platform has its own copyright settings. The State Library of South Australia recommend that 'owner' and 'privacy' settings as well as 'content filters', remain as the default
- default settings for owner license and privacy are retained and content filters remain as 'safe'
- Items which contain images/references to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people may be accompanied by warning text to indicate that the work may include people who have passed away.
- Media, comments and/or learning samples which contain images of or references to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people will be accompanied by warning text to indicate that the work may include references to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who have passed away.
