### **ENGAGE LEARNERS**

Share the Invitation for children and young people with participants Share examples with learners such as <u>https://www.channel4.com/news/view-from-the-window-how-children-are-experiencing-the-coronavirus-crisis.</u> or <u>Sign up to flickr</u> and then <u>Join the Public Group: COVID-19 Through Young</u> <u>Eyes</u> to view responses from other children in SA

### **OBTAIN AND SEND CONSENT FORMS**

Obtain a Consent Form Talent Release for each child or young person that participates. Scan forms (most likely via your school photocopier) as separate files or as a single PDF file Upload Consent Form Talent release for participants into your Dropbox folder

### CONVERT PARTICIPANT RESPONSES TO DIGITAL FORMAT

Participant responses created on A4 or A3 paper can be individually scanned as an image file (jpg, png, gif) and at the highest dpi available

Larger or 3D responses that are unable to be scanned, can be photographed

We recommend keeping videos to under 2 minutes

Flickr accepts the following file types:

- Images: jpg, png, gif (non-animated) max file size 200MB
- Video: mp4, avi, wmv, mov, mpeg, 3gp, m2ts, ogg, ogv max file size 1GB

# ADD PHOTOS, IMAGES AND VIDEOS TO YOUR FLICKR ACCOUNT

In your flickr account add the photos/images and videos of participants.

- Go to the upload button
- Either drag and drop photos, images and videos OR click the upload button
- Choose the files then click open.
- This will display the images you are intending to upload to flickr.
- Add a description for each image with first name and age of participant/s, school name is optional. You may also include a short description to accompany the image or video
- Owner and Privacy settings as well as content filters, remain as the default
- Click the 'Upload' button.

Your Photostream will now display the participant submissions

### SHARE IMAGES AND/OR VIDEOS TO THE PUBLIC GROUP: COVID-19 THROUGH YOUNG EYES

<u>Go to the Public Group: COVID-19 Through Young Eyes</u> Click 'Add some photos' Select the images or videos in **Your Photostream** that you want to add

### INVITE FAMILIES TO VIEW THE GROUP

Send the following links to families to invite them to sign up to flickr (if not already a member) and then join the group, COVID-19 Through Young Eyes <u>Sign up to flickr</u> and then Join the Public Group: COVID-19 Through Young Eyes

Once the image and video files have been shared with the COVID-19 Through Young Eyes group, the State Library's collection development team will consider them for inclusion within the collection.
