LEARNING WITH THE STATE LIBRARY

History is made up of many, many stories. MY HISTORY is a program that engages children in examining their own personal stories and histories. They explore their State Library to uncover the way collections hold memories and create take-home memory boxes to capture their own unique stories.

Key inquiry questions include:

- What is my personal story? How is my story the same and different from others?
- What people, events, activities and places do I care about? Why?

Many elements of this program have been co-designed with children to provide relevant learning experiences that effectively engage early years learners.

The learning experiences are aligned with the Australian Curriculum, with a particular emphasis on the learning area of Humanities and Social Sciences: History and the general capabilities of literacy, critical and creative thinking. Effective learning principles strongly underpin the learning design.

PRE-VISIT PREPARATION

- □ View the WELCOME TO THE STATE LIBRARY K-6 video. This is designed to include children in the learning process and support them to develop a relationship with and an understanding of the State Library.
- Colour print A3 MY HISTORY ONLINE COLLECTIONS CARDS one page per group. Cut each page in to 6 cards. These 6 cards show images from the State Library Collection and will be used to explore the connections between memory and objects.
- □ **Organise a memory box** for each learner. This might be a reused box from home or you may choose to purchase boxes such as <u>these</u>.
- **Organise groups** of 4 learners and partners within each group to assist with collaborative processes.
- Print INFORMATION FOR SUPPPORTING ADULTS letter to share with adults that may be assisting
