

HOW TO BORROW BOOKS ON THE CATALOGUE

You only need 'One Card'

SA library customers can use any public library across SA with a single card, and have access to over 3 million items. The 'one card' network connects more than 130 public libraries across the State and provides convenient access to the entire public library collection.

Borrowing what you want is just a click away

To get quick access to the books on the booklist, simply search our online catalogue and reserve the item you want - it's easy and free! When your item becomes available you can be notified by email or SMS & you can pick up from your preferred library.

Becoming a member

Join online at <u>libraries.sa.gov.au/join</u> for digital membership to access digital items such as eBooks.

If you wish to borrow physical items/books, you'll need to visit your library in person with identification to create a membership or upgrade your digital membership - check with your local library as to the identification you'll require.







Searching the online catalogue

- → Go to <u>libraries.sa.gov.au</u>
- \rightarrow Locate the online catalogue at the top of the page



- → In the 'Search catalogue' field, type the title of the book/item you would like to borrow along with the surname of the author
- \rightarrow Click on the 'search' button

Reserving using the online catalogue

- → Once you have searched for the book you would like to borrow, locate the book and click on the title or photo of the book (below left)
- → View and scroll down the page (below middle) to read a summary of the book, along with the number and location of book copies available
- \rightarrow Select 'Place Hold' to start the process of reserving a copy of the book
- → Choose your preferred library pick up location and select 'Place Hold' (below right)
- → You will be notified by email or SMS when your book is available to be collected if you provided these contact details when you created your membership
