
LEGO SCAVENGER HUNT

After completing her delivery voyage across the world from Europe, the RSV Nuyina arrived at which Australian city on 16 October 2021?




The first library, museum and gallery of South Australia started in this building.




One of the natural treasures in South Australia.

Like a butterfly finding nectar you might stop and get a drink or a bite to eat.




First Australians used these ingenious nets along rivers.


